- 01 Accessibility features support people across disability, device, language, and environmental contexts.
- 02 Keyboard compatibility and visible focus are essential for many interaction methods.
- 03 Contrast, scalable text, clear layout, and large controls improve visual access.
- 04 Captions, transcripts, text-to-speech support, and text alternatives widen access to media.
- 05 Understandable language and clear notifications help users recover and act.
- 06 Accessibility should be designed, reviewed, tested, and revised with user feedback.
