- 01 Classical conditioning links two stimuli until one begins to cue a learned response.
- 02 Operant conditioning changes behaviour through its consequences.
- 03 Reinforcement raises the likelihood of a behaviour; punishment lowers it.
- 04 Positive and negative refer to adding and removing a stimulus.
- 05 A reinforcement schedule changes how quickly a behaviour is acquired and how long it lasts.
- 06 Effective classroom use begins with an observable behaviour and evidence that it changed.
