- 01 Replace 'understand' and 'appreciate' with an observable performance.
- 02 Align the outcome, assessment, practice, and feedback. Complex abilities need direct rehearsal.
- 03 Use the room available in internal assessment and class time even when the syllabus is fixed.
- 04 Spend interaction on threshold concepts and recurring difficulties. Curate vetted material for simpler content.
- 05 Give every teaching tool a specific job linked to the outcome.
- 06 With AI-generated work, ask students to find errors, test the output, verify results, and explain corrections.
- 07 Keep human interaction, formative feedback, values, and professional judgement at the centre.
- 08 Use a community of practice to compare classroom evidence and revise the course with colleagues.
