- 01 Preprints make manuscripts public before journal review and publication are complete.
- 02 They support rapid access, feedback, visibility, and a dated record.
- 03 Version labels and links help readers follow updates and later publication.
- 04 Readers should assess evidence directly and look for current versions.
- 05 Coauthor consent, journal policy, patents, ethics, and data protection need advance review.
- 06 Repositories should provide screening, versioning, preservation, metadata, and clear policies.
