Verify the publisher, editors, contact details, and venue scope.

02

Read the peer-review, correction, fee, copyright, and archiving policies.

03

Check indexing and identifiers in the claimed external database.

04

Inspect recent content for fit, quality, and editorial consistency.

05

Investigate false metrics, hidden charges, copied pages, and pressure tactics.

06

Keep records and ask a librarian or experienced colleague for a second check.
