What can be verified

For this upload, the official transcript, transcript segments, Show transcript control, and closed captions are unavailable. The opening card reads “Problem Solving — Module 2: Developing skills to identify the real problem.” The public title reads “Extend the Definition & Own the Problem.” The card and public metadata contain no speaker name.

That sets a firm editorial limit. The card verifies that the module concerns identifying the real problem. The public title is the sole source for the themes of “extending” and “owning”. An official transcript or publisher description would be required to confirm how the facilitator explains those themes. This record stays with verified metadata and viewing questions.

While watching, note four things. How does the facilitator separate a symptom from the problem? What information or stakeholders are added when the definition is widened? Where is a sensible boundary placed around the problem? And what does “owning” mean here: accepting blame, coordinating action, following through, or something else? Capture the facilitator’s actual words and examples before interpreting them.

For now, the video is the authority. A fuller summary and a speaker credit need an official transcript or a verified description from the publisher.
