Stereotype threat is triggered by a situation in which a negative group stereotype feels relevant.

02

A student can experience the pressure even when they reject the stereotype.

03

Caring about the domain can make the evaluative threat more consequential.

04

Attention spent managing judgment can interfere with performance.

05

Identity safety comes from credible belonging and fair treatment.

06

The size and generality of the effect remain subjects of research debate.
